## WHERE DOES NATURAL SLATE COME FROM?

Natural slate roofing is quarried from specific regions of the United States, most commonly in the New England area. Large slate slabs are removed from a quarry and sent to a manufacturing facility for grading and color classification.

Once graded, the pieces that naturally look best, without the need for polishing and/or sanding, are selected to become roofing slates. They are cut into specific sizes and packaged together, after nail holes are drilled for roof attachment.
